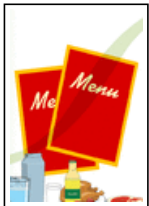

The referendum question on the April 3, 2018 ballot will provide the district the resources needed to meet the expectations of our community:

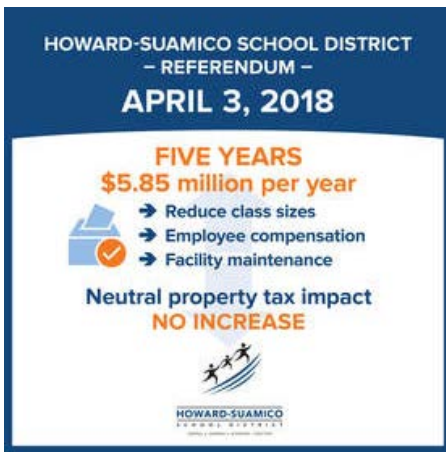
- Reduce class sizes
