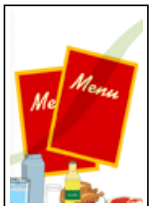

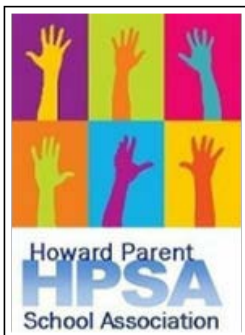


FACILITIES USE CALENDAR

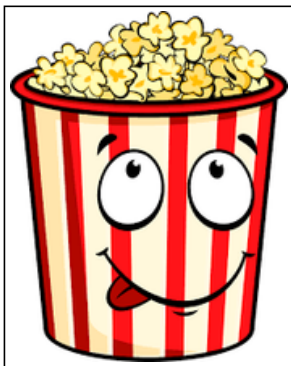
