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

This year's theme, "Show Your Spirit," reminds parents, students and school



Students have learned about personal space in the recent weeks. They have learned about keeping boundaries through using carpet squares, hula hoops, and a bubble activity. Two characters have helped reinforce this idea: Space Invader and Space Respecter. Space Invader gets into people's personal space, while Space Respecter reminds others when they are too close to someone. You can use this language at home if your child needs reminders about personal space. A fun activity to try is to have your children sit near one another.
