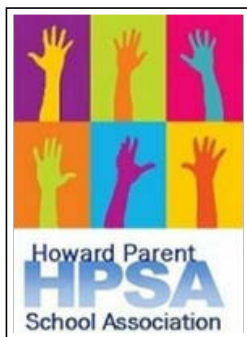




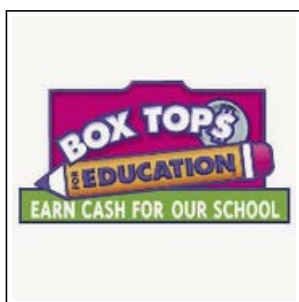
## FACILITIES USE CALENDAR

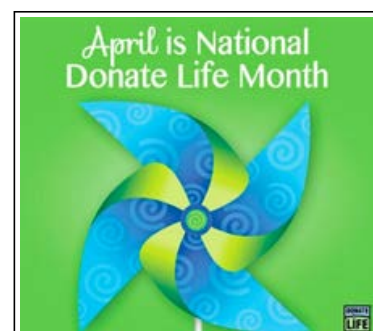
