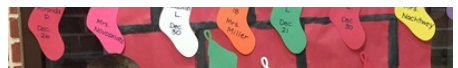
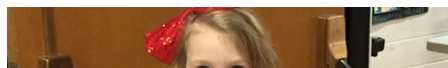
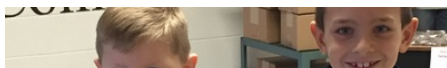
## Lineville Intermediate School Music Choices

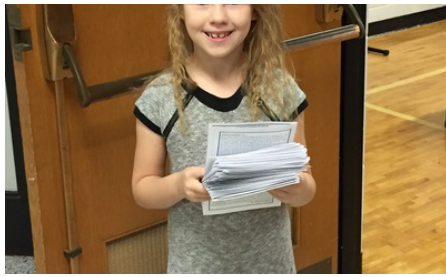
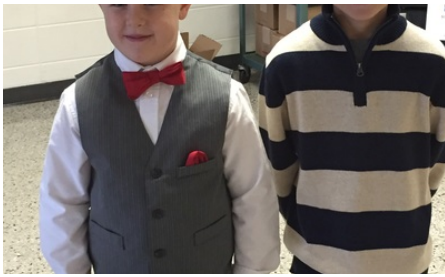
