4K Registration for 2016 - 2017

4K Registration is available online starting **February 1, 2016** on the Howard Suamico District website at www.hssd.k12.wi.us/registration for 2016-2017 using our automated online registration system InfoSnap.

Walk-In Registration will be available at the Howard - Suamico School District Office February 1 (8 am to 4 pm). To secure your child's registration for the 2016-17 school year, the time to register is now. It is important for you complete the registration and provide verifications as soon as possible to finalize the registration process (NOTE: child must be 4-years-old on or before September 1, 2016).

You may register anywhere there is internet access or at a kiosk located at one of the elementary schools or at the district office.

Please bring the following verification documents when registering your child:

- Child's birth certificate or equivalent i.e. passport, hospital birth certificate or complete the Inability to

Child Find is a continuous process of public awareness activities, screening and evaluation designed to locate, identify, and refer as early as possible all young children with disabilities and their families who are in need of an Early Intervention Program (Part C) or Early Childhood Special Education (Part B) services of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

Child Find Screenings are sponsored by the Howard-Suamico School District as a complimentary service to assess a child's developmental progress according to their age. The developmental areas to be screened include the following skills;

- **Social/Emotional**—how your child interacts with others and with their surroundings
- **Expressive & Receptive Language**— how your child uses and understands language, and articulates sounds
- **Gross Motor**—how your child performs age-appropriate skills such as jumping, climbing, and accessing playground equipment
- **Fine Motor**—how your child manipulates toys, everyday items, and writing tools.
- **Cognitive**—how your child demonstrates cognitive skills such as matching, color recognition, reasoning questions, and following directions.
