Weather Related Make-up Time

The District <u>will need to make up time to meet the instructional minutes required</u> by the Department of Public Instruction. Beginning Monday, April 23 there will be 10 minutes added to the beginning of the school day at the elementary schools.

Bus pickup and drop off times <u>will not</u> change. The instructional minutes will be added to the beginning of the school day due to existing transportation schedules.
